Registered Nurse

Registered nurses are concerned with the promotion of health through direct and indirect client care and client teaching. The professional nurse has an interest in helping people; communicates effectively; processes critical thinking and organizational skills; is flexible and has the ability to work collaboratively with other health care personnel and never forget they are patient advocates.

The two year Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) program is intended to develop the necessary knowledge and skill basic to the function of the registered professional nurses in the direct care of patients. The successful completion of this program entitles the student to an Associate Science Degree, and meets the eligibility requirements to take the professional licensing examination to become a registered nurse.

The nursing program is accredited by the California State Board of Registered Nursing (BRN) and by the National League for Nursing (NLNAC).



Career Options

Registered nurses may work in hospitals, extended care facilities, doctor's offices, and clinics or home health care. Multiple fields and career options in: ambulatory care, cardiac catheterization, central service and finance; critical care; dialysis; education; endoscopy; hospice; Operating Room; Emergency Department; gerontology; IV therapy; long term care; medical and surgical nursing; neonatal; obstetrics; oncology; orthopedics; pediatrics; prenatal; psychiatrics; quality assurance; rehabilitation and utilization review.

Salary Range

Entry level nurses may earn between \$25 - \$40 hourly rates dependent upon geographic location and clinical setting.
