Campus Police

If Campus Police extension is not answered, the call forwards to the Channel Islands Dispatch Center. Dispatch will contact Campus Police or Fire/Ambulance, as needed.

Emergency Procedures for Accidents and Acute Illness

Life Threatening Situations

- **Call 1455 (Campus Police/Dispatch) or 911**
- **Give the nature and exact location of the accident or medical emergency**
- **Do not move the victim, unless to prevent further injury**

Non-Life Threatening Situations

- **Call the Student Health Center, extension 1413**
- **If the Student Health Center is closed or a nurse is unavailable, call Campus Police at extension 1455**
- **Give the nature and exact location of the accident or illness**

All campus emergencies, accidents and illness should be reported to the Student Health Center ASAP, using the REPORT OF PERSONAL (NON-EMPLOYEE) ACCIDENT form. These forms are available from the Student Health Center or from the Administration Copy Center. These forms are essential for follow-up of student's condition and possible insurance coverage.
