This is the equivalent of a grade ‘C’ or better, and the units earned are not counted in the student’s GPA. “NP” is used to denote no credit has been earned. This is a less than satisfactory or failing grade and does not count in a student’s GPA. However, units attempted for which NP is recorded shall be considered in probation and dismissal procedures.

I am aware that other colleges and universities may restrict the acceptance of courses taken on a Pass/No Pass basis, especially for satisfaction of major requirements.

I understand that once I have declared the Pass/No Pass grading option and the P/NP deadline has passed, this request cannot be revoked.
