Dear President Luskin:

The Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges, Western Association of Schools and Colleges, at its meeting January 8-10, 2014, reviewed the Midterm Report submitted by Moorpark College. The Report was certified by district and college leadership, including the chair of the governing board, the chancellor, the college president, and leaders of the faculty and staff. Based on the College's report and the documentation submitted, the College has met the Standards associated with College Recommendations 1 – 4, District Recommendations 1 – 7 and two Commission Concerns.

Institutions are expected to meet Eligibility Requirements and Accreditation Standards at all times during the six-year cycle. This group should include the Chancellor, campus leadership, and the Board of Trustees.

The Commission also requires that the Midterm Report and this Commission action letter be made available to students and the public by placing a copy on the College website. *Please note that in response to public interest in disclosure, the Commission now requires institutions to post accreditation information on a page no farther than one click from the institution's home page.*
