


There could be better integration with grant funded projects to reduce duplication of efforts.

By including oversight of categorical funded projects.


More effective dissemination of the final prioritized lists so that the college in general is more aware of the process and results.


Go over 10 + 1 annually with the committee members.

The categorical piece is not decided in an open and cooperative environment. It seems to be shrouded in secrecy with little to no vetting with the committee.


Include projects generated through categorical funding sources in the complete vetting process.
