Proctorio, the video proctor for online/hybrid classes, is now available to Moorpark. I will be getting trained and then offer trainings for online and hybrid instructors.

The district purchased Ally, an accessibility program that is integrated into Canvas. The project kicked-off on October 26, all three colleges' Instructional Designers will be trained on Ally. After then I will offer trainings for our faculty and staff.

There are two trainings this month:
