

Excerpt from Making Decisions Document

2.1.2.2 Committee on Accreditation and Planning –Facilities and Technology Charter: The Facilities and Technology Committee on Accreditation and Planning makes recommendations on college-wide planning and accreditation issues related to facilities for educational programs and student service and those related to campus instructional and administrative digital technology. The planning component under the purview of the Facilities and Technology Committee on Accreditations and Planning includes:

- Develop/Monitor Facilities Master Plan
- Develop and annually update the Technology Operations Plan
- Review the Campus Technology Master Plan every three years
- Monitor the annual technology inventory for the purposes of technology refresh
- Prioritize technology-review and prioritize technology related issues and resources identified in annual program plans, make recommendations, and report results to programs and the general campus
- Prioritize facilities – review and prioritize facilities related issues and resources identified in annual program plans, make recommendations, and report results to programs and the general campus
- Prioritize secondary effect and space allocation issues identified by the Facilities and Technology Workgroups

The accreditation component under the purview of the Facilities and Technology Committee on Accreditation and Planning is the development of plans to address any self-study advisement or visiting team recommendations that refer to facilities and/ or the needs of digital technology for students, faculty, and staff.

Co-chair: Vice President of Business Services
Faculty member elected by the Academic Senate Council and is, therefore, a member of the Academic Senate Council

Members:

- Three faculty members from each Student Learning Division ratified by the Academic Senate Council
- Three Classified representatives as appointed by Classified Senate
- One representative from Accessibility Coordination Center and Education Support Services
- One representative from Instructional Technology
- Two Deans appointed by the Vice President of Instruction (CIO)
- Three Business Service representatives selected by the Vice President of Business Services
- One representative from Student Services Council appointed by the Vice President of Student Services (CSSO)
- One student appointed by Associated Students who serves in an advisory role
- Academic Senate President (ex-officio, non-voting)
- Vice President of Instruction (CIO) (ex-officio, non-voting)
- Vice President of Student Services (CSSO) (ex-officio, non-voting)
