## AA Degree in General Studies – Pattern II or III

(for students with catalog rights of Fall 2008 or thereafter)

<u>Pattern II</u> – is for students who are planning to transfer to a four-year university in high-unit majors or where completion of CSU GE or IGETC is not appropriate or advisable.

<u>Pattern III</u> - is designed for students who are planning to transfer to a California four-year university (UC or CSU) and plan to use the CSU GE or IGETC pattern to fulfill their lower division general education requirements.
