We are taking steps Fall 2017 to increase open lab time in HSS-104 via two paid CTE Strong Workforce interns serving as lab assistants. This second lab, however, can offset the limited range of hours HSS-104 will be available (as it is a classroom for six courses). We propose the use of a student fee to offset costs of toner and paper longterm.
