Facilities Master Plan - Continue to monitor the facility projects in relation to the college's Facilities Master Plan and the guidelines in the accreditation self-study.	Monthly updates are given to committee on status of projects in the plan as well as local projects. Progress is monitored along with mid-course corrections are made.
Facilities Master Plan Update Schedule - Review and develop a process to update the college's Facilities Master Plan in relation to the Education Master Plan and the Technology Plan. The Facilities Master Plan is scheduled to be updated every three years.	Facilities Master Plan has been reviewed and discussions began for process development. More work and reflection to occur on the Facilities Plan as the major effort have been directed towards the Education and Technology Plans.
Secondary Effects – Begin discussion on the secondary effects to the Financial Aid, EOPS, ACCESS, and Health Sciences modular buildings in the expansion of the Campus Center Building.	Discussions began and a plan developed for all aspects of the secondary effects of the LLR Project.
Review need to expand parking for students and staff.	Discussions have expanded to include planning for a new campus parking structure.
Review opportunities and implement green technology initiatives throughout the campus.	Green technologies and LEED designations have been discussed at a number of meetings regarding the renovation of the Campus Center building, parking structure, and Academic Center.
*Way Finding – Review and improve existing and proposed sidewalks, pathways, signage, and campus beautification projects, etc. as they impact campus construction and renovation projects.	The Committee adopted this project and has moved ahead with commissioning architectural drawings and renderings.
*Special Repairs – Review and prioritize repairs and renovations to existing buildings utilizing bond funds.	A list has been developed from deferred/scheduled maintenance projects.
