- Financial impact on District and Moorpark college will continue

- FTES remain about the same
- Further cuts can still go into effect
- AS Degree requirements from State

State of the Department

- Fewer classes than last year
- Further reduction in CRNs
- Reductions to FTES
- Reorganization of Certificates and Proficiencies
- Focus on core class offerings
 Basic Skills, AS Degree, Transfer to a 4 year
