

Moorpark Music Students Can Earn BFA Degrees at CalArts



Transfer Agreement Offers Moorpark College Music Students Priority Consideration and Pathway to CalArts

The Herb Alpert School of Music at CalArts has developed a student transfer agreement with Moorpark College's Music Department. The agreement gives Moorpark music students who are interested in earning a BFA degree in music priority consideration and a clear transfer pathway to CalArts.

Applicants from Moorpark College need 60 units of baccalaureate level work to transfer to CalArts at the BFA 3 (aka junior standing) level, including 22 units of general education courses. While the transfer agreement does not guarantee admission to CalArts, it does provide priority consideration toward

admission and individual guidance for transferring students. Year level placement is based on the portfolio and at the discretion of faculty upon acceptance to CalArts. CalArts waives the application fee.

All students admitted to CalArts, including Moorpark transfer students, will take the Music Theory & Skills Placement Examinations during Orientation week (their first week at CalArts). Placement into specific music courses will be determined by the proficiency demonstrated on these exams. Final degree requirements are determined by the CalArts catalog current at the time students enroll.
