Transfer Agreement Offers Moorpark College Photography Students Priority Consideration and Pathway to CalArts

The CalArts School of Art's Photography & Media Program has developed a student transfer pathway with Moorpark College. The agreement gives Moorpark photography students who are interested in earning a BFA degree in Photography & Media priority consideration and a clear transfer pathway to CalArts.

Applicants from Moorpark College need 60 units of baccalaureate level work to transfer to CalArts at the BFA 3 (aka junior standing) level, including 22 units of general education courses. Year level placement is based on the portfolio and at the discretion of faculty upon

acceptance to CalArts. While the transfer agreement does not guarantee admission to CalArts, it does provide priority consideration toward admission and individual guidance for transferring students. CalArts waives the application fee.
