  - How do we communicate across the department/college? How do we maintain? Best cross collaboration to benefit student
    - Suggestions/Concerns:
      - 1. Faculty of Guided Pathways to review the ballot and bring back changes
      - Input and feedback should be early on to eliminate a lot of the back and forth changes after Technical Review
      - 3. Faculty member should be both at Success Team level and Curriculum Committee level
      - 4. Is Success Team temporary? Response: not temporary, but roles will change when grant is no longer available; members might change. Do not know how it will change. Possibly extending beyond the grant to a new model, but need systems to communicate.
      - 5. Maybe have counseling bring back information to Guided Pathways
      - The missing piece could be early in the process during development or revision because J.
         Dickey and L. Mai currently report changes back to counselors
      - 7. Add agenda item to provide Guided Pathway faculty to discuss curriculum changes
