VI. DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. Proposed CalGETC Pathway

- L. Mai reviewed the <u>General Education Pathway</u>
- Only the beginning, still need approvals for a potential Fall 2024 adoption. Details to follow.
 - Aligned CSU GE and IGETC and came up with proposed CalGETC Program, related to AB 928
 - Requires 11 courses (34 semester units)



- Proposed (Local) CCC Associate degree GE Pathway
 - Requires 21 semester units
- Proposed CCC Baccalaureate Degree GE Pathway (Lower Division), related AB 927
 - Requires 27 semester units

B. Bachelor program updates

- President Julius Sokenu, along with other presidents, from colleges that submitted proposals that had CSU objections, showed up to the Board of Governors (BOG) meeting to advocate for the bachelor's degrees.
 - A BioTech student spoke during public comment (student perspective)
 - Industry partner spoke during public comment (industry perspective)
 - Dr. Subhash Karkare spoke during public comment (faculty perspective)
 - The BOG publicly supported our proposals
- Next round of submissions is January 13, 2023. The Moorpark College Bachelor of Science Degree Advisory Committee is working on submitting a Cybersecurity degree, which is similar to a bachelor's degree proposal submitted that received CSU objections; we anticipate some pushback.
- There has to be an agreement, but that agreement does not need to be an approval;
 BOG have final say.
- Earliest bachelor's programs to be Fall 2024

VII. REPORTS AND INFORMATION

A. Co-Chair Report

- Credit for Prior Learning (CPL) discussed parameters for granting CPL
- Concerns due to workload and compensation



- Response: We don't have control over Human Resources, but we need to move forward and get best practices for granting CPL. The goal is to begin with industry certification and CTE.
- Suggestions made to edit CPL form, and will share those edits once revised form is ready

B. DCCI

- Presented Film Studies, Associate in Arts and a course with a SAM Code correction.
- Both were forwarded to the next Board of Trustees meeting for approval
