#### B. Co-Chair Report

Bachelor's Degree for Biomanufacturing – John Forbes

A team from Moorpark College will be attending the Bachelor's Degree Program workshop on March 2-3, 2023 hosted at Golden West College. The MC Team includes representatives from counseling, articulation, A&R, curriculum specialist, financial aid and some discipline faculty. The team will share and report back at the March meeting.

### B. Credit for Prior Learning (CPL) – Scarlet Relle

The districtwide workgroup met on Thursday Jan 26, 2023, via Zoom.

- > There was more representation from OC than VC.
- Following the meeting, MC shared with OC and VC our list of courses that faculty have deemed eligible for CPL. The file is to be used as template and to help their faculty facilitate the discussion and determination of courses that will be available for CPL at their own campus.
- One of the goals is to create uniformity across our district for courses available for CPL and their assessment method. For example, if MC decides that an ENGR course is not appropriate for CPL but OC does, then the student can go to OC and get CPL credit for that course. We need to make sure that this does not happen.
