

**General Studies Associate in Arts Degree - Pattern II or III**

This pattern is for students who begin (or return) their college education for Fall 2008 or thereafter

**Pattern II** –is for students who are planning to transfer to a four-year university in high-unit majors or where completion of CSU GE or IGETC is not appropriate or advisable.

**Pattern III** - is designed for students who are planning to transfer to a California four-year university and plan to use the CSU GE or IGETC pattern to fulfill their lower division general education requirements.

**NOTE:** Transfer requirements vary depending on major and transfer institution selected. Consult with the intended transfer institution, a Moorpark College counselor, and [www.assist.org](http://www.assist.org) (for UC/CSU) for admission, general education, and major requirements.
