

General Studies Associate in Arts Degree - Pattern II or III

This pattern is for students who begin (or return) their college education for Fall 2008 or thereafter

Pattern II –is for students who are planning to transfer to a four-year university in high-unit majors or where completion of CSU GE or IGETC is not appropriate or advisable.

Pattern III - is designed for students who are planning to transfer to a California four-year university and plan to use the CSU GE or IGETC pattern to fulfill their lower division general education requirements.

NOTE: Transfer requirements vary depending on major and transfer institution selected. Consult with the intended transfer institution, a Moorpark College counselor, and www.assist.org (for UC/CSU) for admission, general education, and major requirements.
