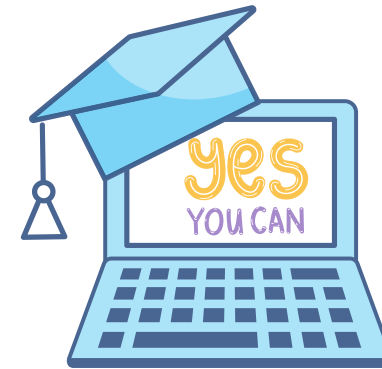

## **Honors Program** •

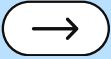
Associated with UCLA (known as TAP-Transfer Alliance Program).

## **Majors** •

TAP specific to majors in the UCLA College of Letters & Sciences approved

## **Opportunity** •

Although not a "guaranteed admission," is a 2nd look at your application for admission.

## Major Selection

## Preparatory Coursework

Major prep coursework identified, satisfies requirements for all 9 UC Campuses

## Competitive Option

Not a guarantee; however, better preparedness to graduate from UC after 2 years

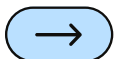

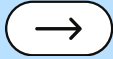

WUE is a program where students in the Western states may enroll in participating universities at a reduced tuition level: up to 150% of the institutions regular resident tuition

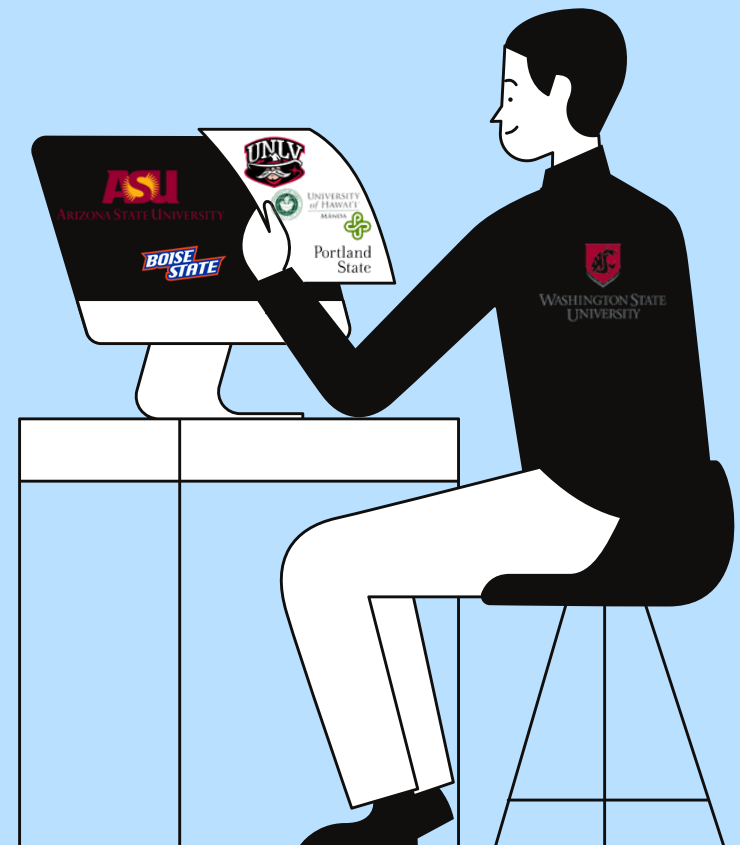
- **Participating States**

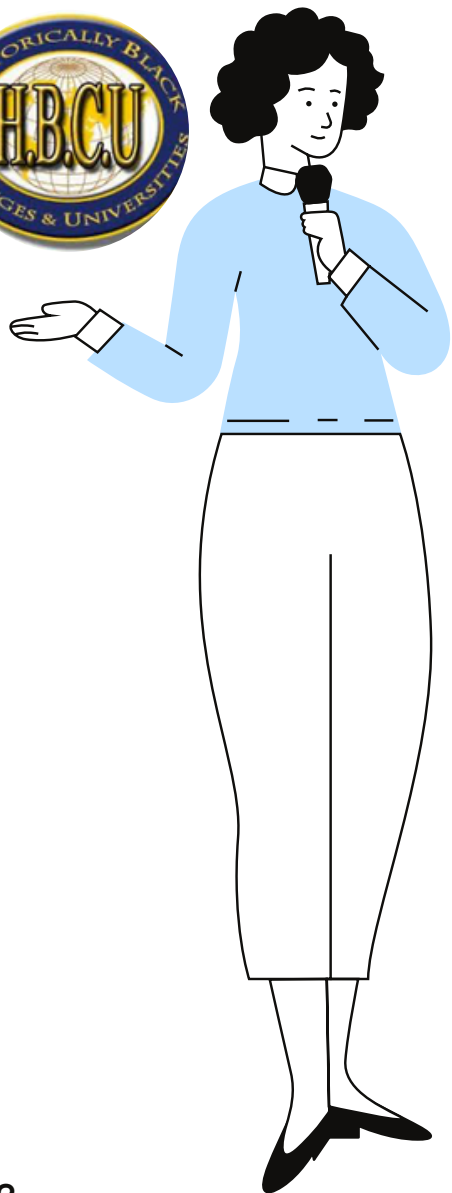

# HBCU

## Historically Black Colleges & Universities

### Goal

The goal of the Historically Black Colleges and Universities Transfer Guarantee Project is to educate students about additional transfer opportunities at these institutions and develop pathways that will ultimately contribute to an increase in baccalaureate degree attainment. Talk to a counselor to learn more about transferring to an HBCU.

### Campuses & Transfer Agreements

#### Objective

Historically black colleges and universities were established primarily to serve the higher education needs of the black community, however they are open to students of any ethnicity.

There are 105 historically black colleges and universities in the country, with most located in the South and East Coast. They all award bachelor's degrees in many fields. Some also award masters and doctorate degrees.

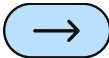


### General Transfer Requirements

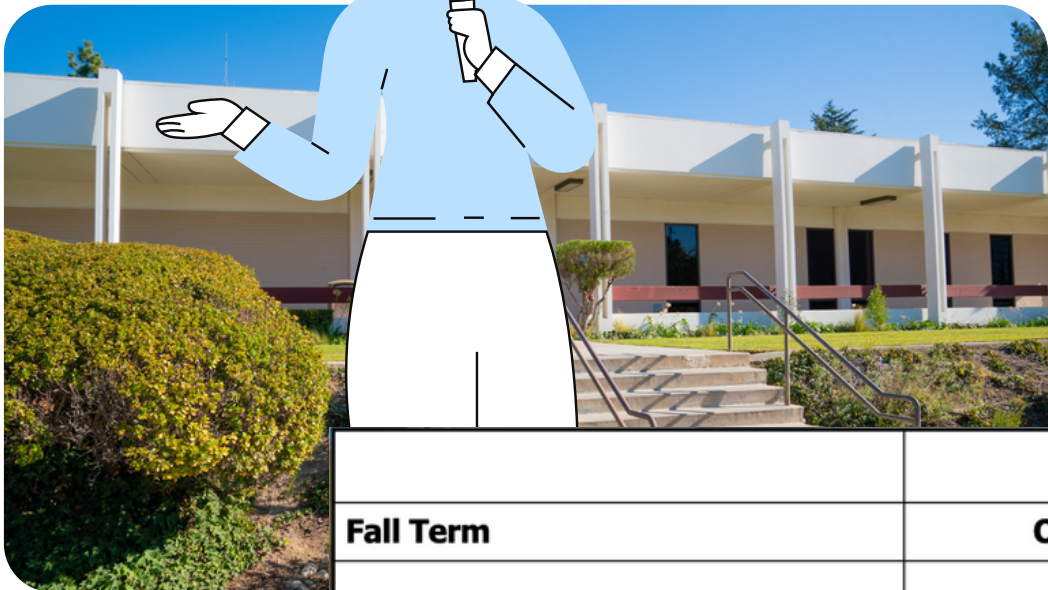
#### Transfer From a California Community College

1. An Associate Degree Awarded by a California Community College with a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher.
2. A minimum of 30 transferable semester units with a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher.
3. California Community College (CCC) students who complete certain academic requirements are guaranteed transfer to a participating HBCU.
