The District maintains shower facilities for student use on campus that may be used by any homeless student who is enrolled in any credit or non-credit course(s) ~~a minimum of nine (9) units of coursework~~, has paid enrollment fees, and is in good standing with the district.

A homeless student is defined as a student who does not have a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence. This includes, but is not limited to, students who: are sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason; are living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or camping grounds due to lack of alternative accommodations; are living in emergency or transitional shelters; have a primary nighttime residence that is a public or private place not designated for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings; or are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations, or similar settings.

Shower facilities are located at each college ~~and are open to use by homeless students at hours prescribed by college president.~~ ~~for a minimum of two (2) hours during normal school hours which do not conflict with the intercollegiate athletic program at each college.~~ In the event that these hours conflict with the hours of an intercollegiate athletic program, the district will provide an alternative schedule ~~at the direction of the college president.~~ ~~for use of the shower facilities.~~
