- a) Student Success – review of “SSSPPlan 2014-2015 Draft v8.pdf”
 - i) We have received approximately \$1.6M, which must be spent by June of 2015.
 - ii) This falls under categorical funds, which does not mean it will be renewable and repeat.
 - iii) The draft we are considering here is for this year.
 - iv) DSPS (or ACCESS)
 - (1) If a faculty prioritization comes up for a position in this regard, there are categorical funds that could allow for that hiring.
 - v) Dean position
 - (1) If there is a new hire, this person would assume responsibilities for Student Success
 - (2) This position would be funded out of three separate sources
 - vi) There are several classified positions we are requesting.
 - vii) Comment: all colleges seem to be spending in the same way, creating positions for counseling and supportive staff.
 - viii) Motion to approve document – Approved unanimously.**
- b) Student Equity
 - i) Concerns going forward
 - (1) Our college has different equity concerns as our sister colleges.
 - (2) Students over 25, foster youth, and evening students need attention
 - ii) This budget comes to nearly \$400,000.
 - (1) There was a request for numbers for the budget. This is supplied today in the document “Student Equity Budget FY2014-15” (request document for upload on site)
 - (2) Question: why is the cost of the new research analyst for 8 months less than the research analyst for 4 months?
 - (a) We will follow up to provide this answer
 - (3) This budget is consistent with what other colleges are doing
 - (4) Question: will there be a program plan for student success and a program plan for student equity?
 - (a) Yes, in the future. It will be under the EVP and the department program plans.

(b) Follow up: Concern here is that accreditation and student success are at odds. Response: this is a systemic issue, not necessarily our college. This is widely acknowledged, and we have done what we can to work with what has come to us. On multiple levels we see a need for processes to be put in place to ensure wise choices.
