Howard mentioned that the District is moving towards purchasing a new Online Orientation. He will email out the demo product for review. ○ Question whether Math and English bridge could be incorporated as a GPS activity; Jesus replied that this would be a good idea to implement as many students struggle in making the transition from HS to College in these subjects. ○ Question whether only online application limits access; paper apps could be printed and distributed ○ Question about recruitment at the high schools and whether they only talk about GPS or other programs; Jesus is working with April in Outreach to incorporate a broad approach to MC programs. ○ Concern shared that with recruitment and outreach occurring not only with GPS but other MC programs, how can we make sure there's coordination and organized visits?
