Producers and directors create television shows, live theater, motion pictures and other performing art productions. They interpret a writer's script in addition to finding financing of the project, coordinating writing, directing and editing.

Film and Video Editor \$22.25/hr.-\$46,280 49,500 +3%

These editors edit moving images on film, video or other media. Their work entails editing films and videotapes to synchronize soundtracks with images. They would also trim film segments to specified lengths and reassemble segments in sequences that present stories with maximum effect.

Broadcast Technician \$19.81/hr.-\$41,200 121,400 +9%

Broadcast technicians set up, operate, and maintain electronic equipment used to transmit radio and television programs. They operate transmitters and control audio equipment to regulate volume level and quality of sound during radio and television broadcasts.
