Announcers speak or read from scripts, such as news reports or commercials. They are frequently asked to host civic, charitable or promotional events that are broadcast, and/or interview show guests about their lives, work or other topics.

Actors play parts in stage, television, radio and motion picture productions for entertainment, information or instruction. Actors interpret serious or comic roles by speech, gesture and body movement to entertain or inform audiences. Other opportunities include theme parks and other live events.

Producer and Director \$34.31/hr.-\$71,350 103,500 +3%

Producers and directors interpret a writer's script to entertain or inform an audience. They create motion pictures, television shows, live theatre and other performing arts productions. Producers also have the responsibility of arranging financing.
