**CalWORKs Work-Study program subsidizes
student employment while providing Cal-
WORKs students with valuable work experi-
ence.**

**The CalWORKs Work-Study program provides
the following services:**

- Supports student employment opportunity (on-campus/off campus). The CalWORKs program is able to reimburse employers a percentage (50-75%) of a student's wages.
- Participation in the CalWORKs Work-Study program allows students to keep 100% of their cash grant.
- Provides students with opportunity to complete activity hours and required WTW hours.
- Provides CalWORKs students with work experience that build job skills for future employment.
