Don't Forget to Make Your 3 Appointments



All EOPS students are required to meet with an EOPS counselor three times each semester and return a Progress Verification Report (PVR). The appointments for Fall 2018 begin on Wednesday, August 1 and end on Wednesday, December 12. Submit your PVR September 24 through October 19.

Your appointments must be at least three weeks apart from each other. Make your first appointment between August 1 and September 21; second appointment between September 24 and October 31; and third appointment between November 1 and December 12.

To schedule an appointment please either come to the EOPS office located in the SSA 107A or call (805) 378-1464. Our office hours are:

If you are planning to transfer for Fall 2019, this semester is very important for you to be aware of transfer deadlines and events that can help you with the transfer process. The Career/Transfer Center will offer various workshops to help you apply on time. Representatives from various

universities will visit Moorpark College to assist students with questions related to transfer into specific universities. Their schedule is available online at Career/Transfer webpage at https://www.moorparkcollege.edu/departments/student-services/career-transfer-center. Please reserve your appointments with each university representative by contacting the Career/Transfer Center.



Also, if you are planning to transfer to one of the UC campuses that participate in Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG), the application period is September 1-30. The Career/Transfer Center will host several TAG workshops that can help you complete your TAG application and submit it by the deadline.

In addition, there will be several workshops for UC and CSU Application Assistance.

Please RSVP for any/all of the events you wish to attend to guarantee your spot.
