New Business	<ul> <li>Revised Committee Charter and membership         <ul> <li>Suggestions for edits included increasing # of Deans to 3 (1 appointed by VPSS, 2 appointed by VPAA)</li> <li>Proposed changes to be sent to Academic Senate for review</li> </ul> </li> <li>SSSP Data Presentation by Institutional Research         <ul> <li>Rocio Cervantes shared Tableaux data which showed that new students who completed SSSP services had higher success and retention than those who did not.</li> <li>Data was culled from Fall 2014 to Fall 2016 and on average demonstrated increasingly higher numbers each year for completed services (orientation, counseling, education planning)</li> <li>Numbers also showed that while new students are not required to meet with a counselor in their first semester, many are having 1 or more meetings with counselors.</li> <li>Question regarding EOPS and ACCESS data: students are required to complete all services but the Tableaux report indicated less than 100% participation (will need to review how services are input and marked "completed" in GradesFirst/Banner)</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
