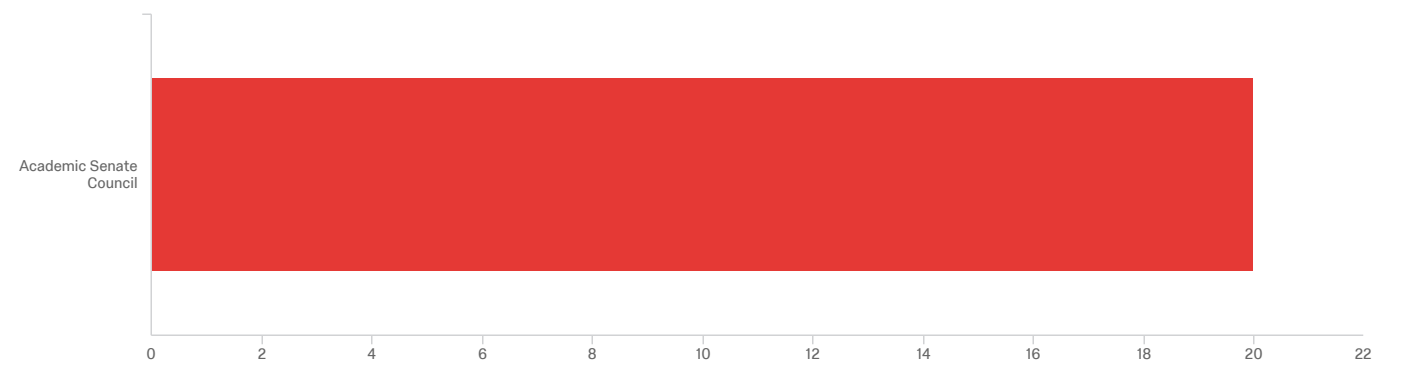

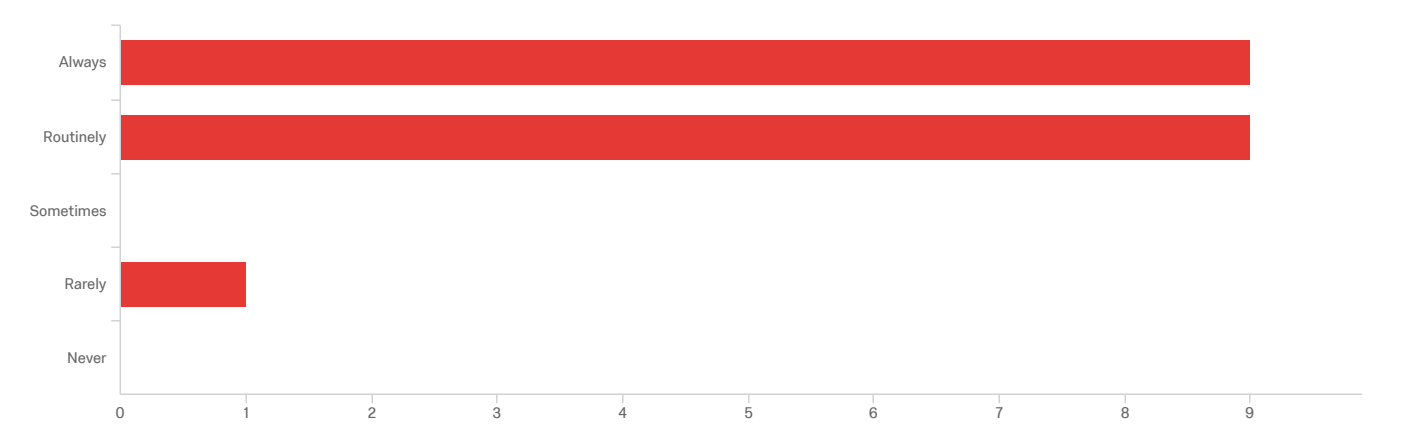
Q1 - Select the committee you served on this academic year, for which you are completing this survey. (If you served on more than one committee you will get this survey more than once.)

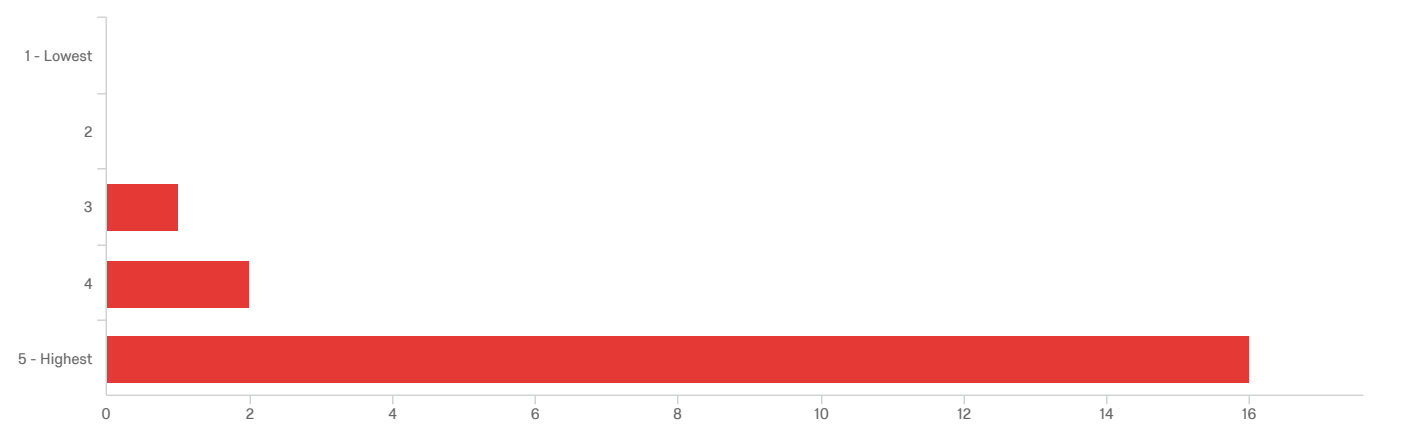

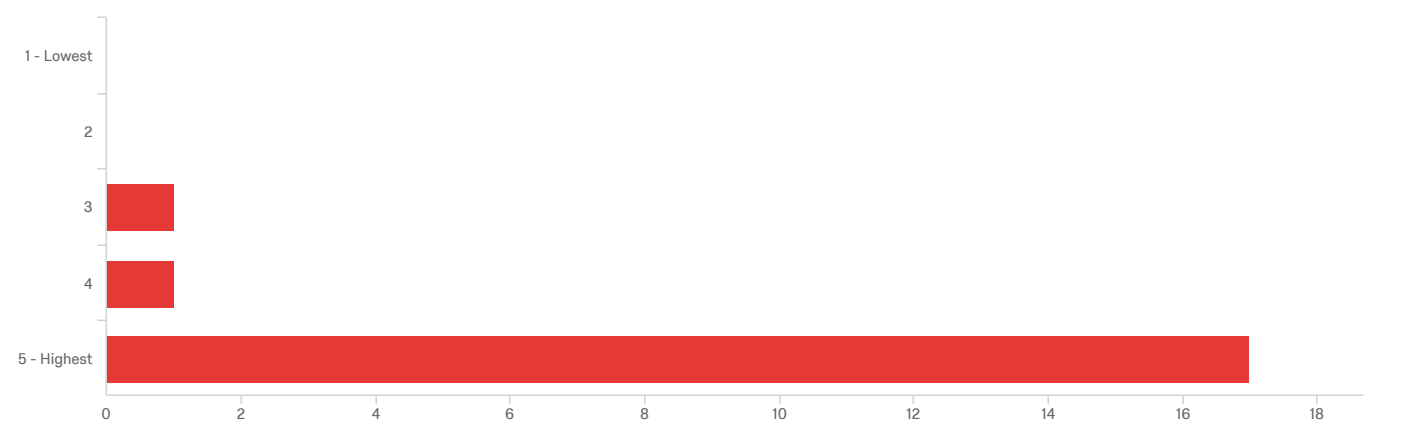
Academic Senate is effective—but effectiveness is irrelevant when management disregards to makes preemptive decisions.

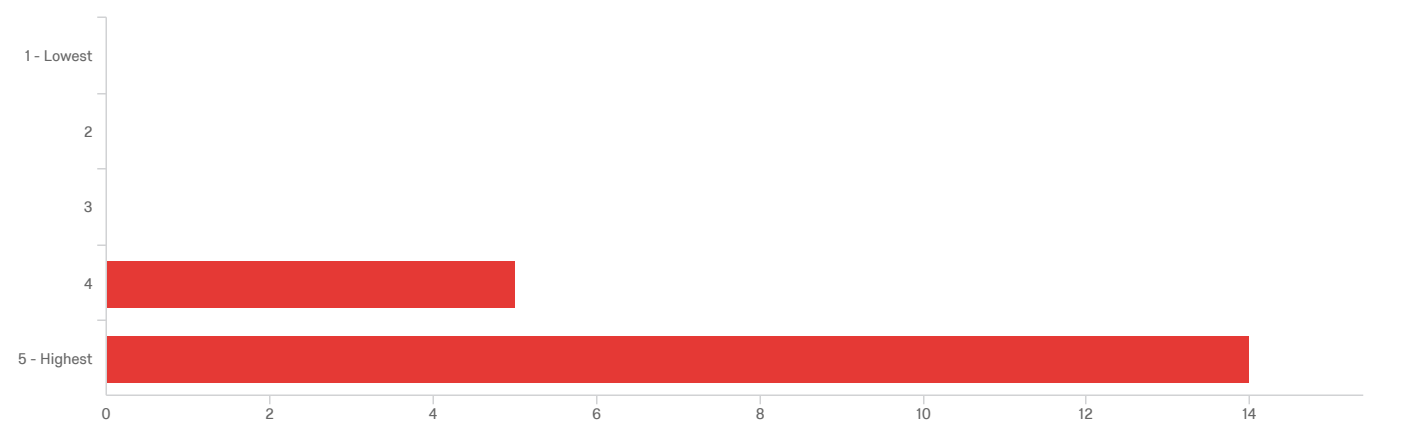
How could the committee improve the value of its work?

It's a fine line between support and positive critique.

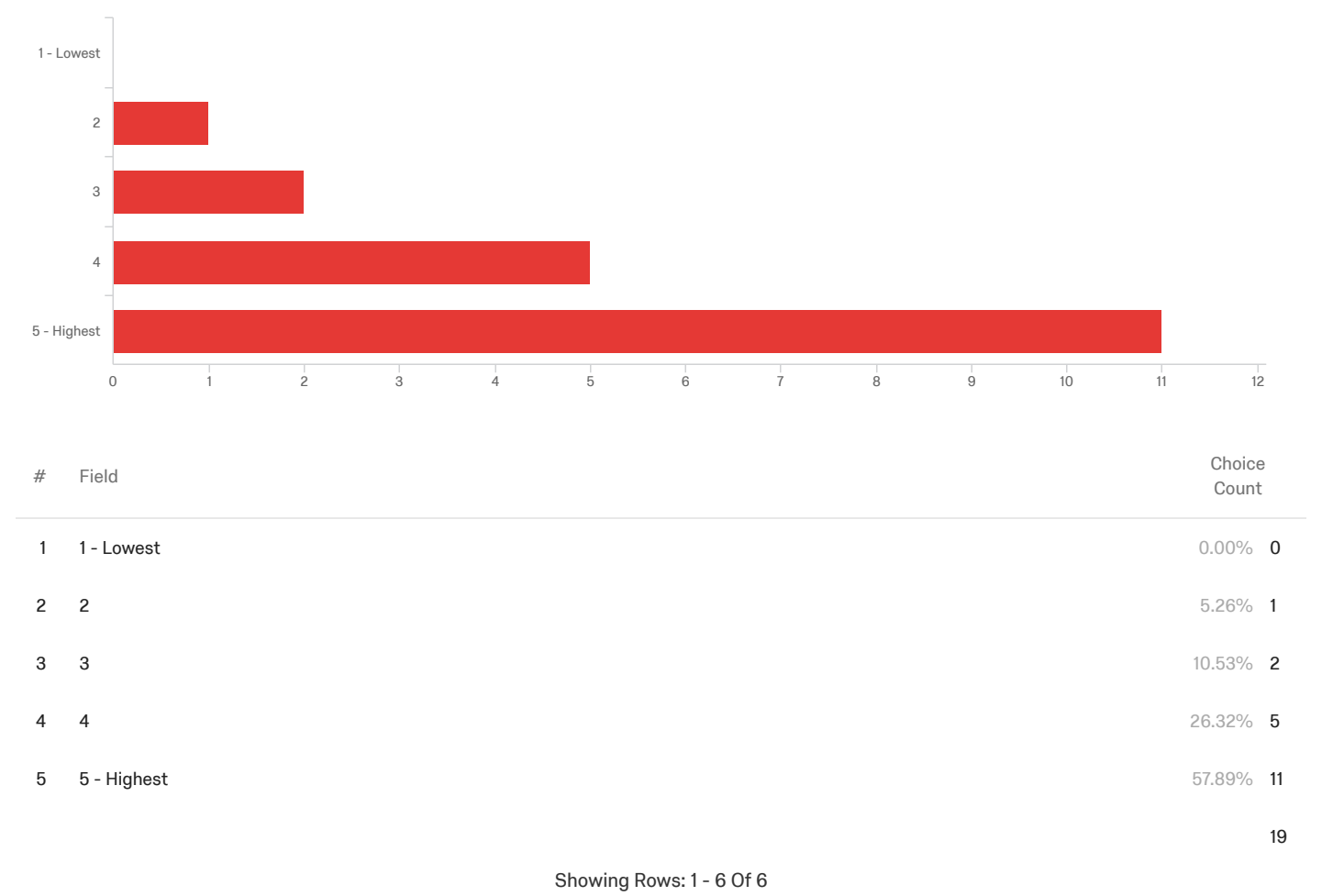
More interaction and communication with administration. Are we doing things that will actually matter?

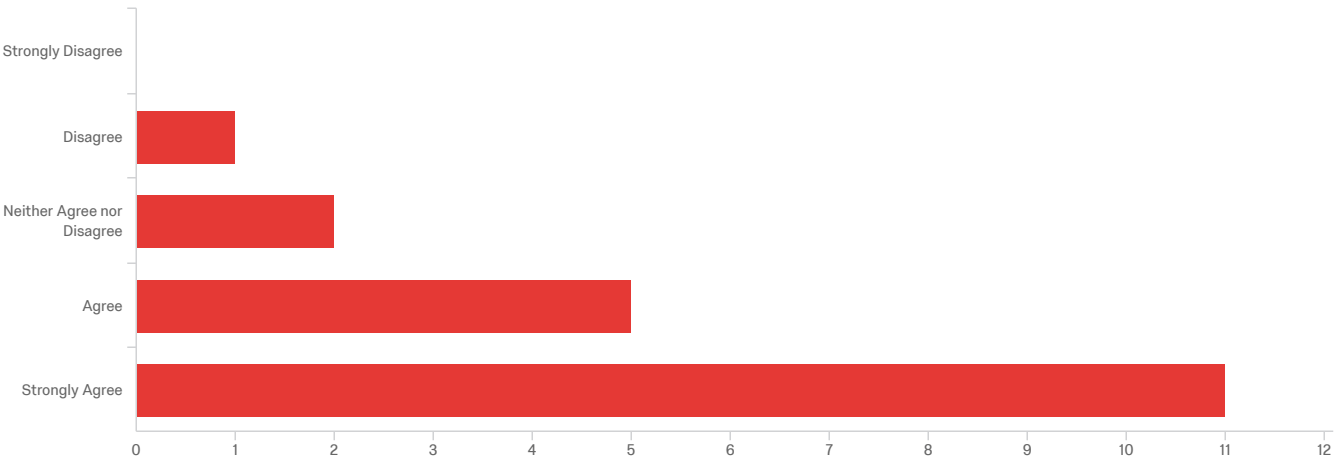
I'd like to know more about ASB activities
