Dr. Bennett agreed with the text box per check box proposal and also asked that the items be numbered 1, 2, 3, etc. The Committee expressed some concern over the capitalization or lack of in some of the text in each item box. Jerry stated that was how we submitted it to Curricunet and should be able to change it. Jerry also stated that Curricunet was working to resolve an issue with unmatching values. The Committee inquired as to whether the check boxes would affect other courses in Curricunet. Dr. Bennett asked that the Committee investigate the matter outside of the Curriculum Committee and present results later.
