A. Prioritization of CORs from Tech-to-Curriculum

Jerry Mansfield discussed the following details in regards to the prioritization process for courses and programs from Tech Review to Curriculum Meeting:

- Effective Date: Courses/Programs that have been marked for an earlier effective date other than our agreedupon Fall start date (and have been approved at Tech Review).
- **State Submissions:** Courses/Programs that need approval by the District, Board, and State (e.g., C-ID submissions, new courses/programs, substantial revisions, standalone courses, and program deletions).
- **Everything Else:** Outline updates, technical revisions and course deletions that will be approved locally on campus.

B. End of the semester Course Impact and Program project

Course Impact reports will be populated for each inactive course being deleted to ensure that any degree(s) affected by the deletion of such courses will be updated by the removal of courses. A detailed process will be discussed at the upcoming meeting.

C. Faculty Co-chair selection process

Jerry presented the committee with a projection of guidelines a sub-committee on Curriculum Faculty Co-Chair selection had developed in March, 2009. Jerry wanted to ensure the committee knew these guidelines had previously been discussed and should be accessed and reviewed by the current committee, as Academic Senate is trying to align their current Co-Chair selection process. He discussed these guidelines were developed for the committee to recommend a faculty nominee to Academic Senate.
