#### **DISCUSSION:**

#### A. Credit Limitations

Letrisha Mai, Articulation Officer, explained the different types of credit limitations on courses currently offered at Moorpark College. She also explained the need for clarification on how these courses are assigned and labeled in the catalog where a credit limitation is placed by University of California (UC). In addition, Letrisha proposed departments should review if the credit limitation placed by UC for courses within each discipline should have the same credit limitation placed for Moorpark College credit as well. Note: UC credit limitation will still be placed on courses, even if the same credit limitation courses at Moorpark College is not adopted.
