Meeting began at 1:04 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: January 13, 2015

Co-Chair Jerry Mansfield called for a motion to approve the January 13th, 2015 Meeting Minutes. Candice Larson motioned for approval. Wade Bradford seconded the motion. Motion carried.

DISCUSSION:

A. CTE Pathways – Julius Sokenu

Lori Bennett, Executive Vice President, introduced the Career Pathways presenters, Julius Sokenu, Karen Nicolas, and Tim Samoff, to the committee and explained there is a regional process being developed for the career pathways. Julius Sokenu detailed there are 72 pathways distributed into three phases. He discussed the importance of the Career Technical Education (CTE) programs, and how they assist those students in High School and Adult Education programs exploring or choosing a career pathway that connects them to the work industry. Tim Samoff shared his own experiences on meeting with high schools to articulate courses and further advises them on how to develop curriculum. Tim mentioned he currently has a high school teacher as a student in one of his courses, with the possibility of implementing the learned curriculum at the high school level. Candice Larson also shared her experiences on meeting with local highs schools and articulating courses, and using rubrics to further expand the high schools' curriculum. Karen Nicolas, Regional Career Pathways Director at South Coast Regional Consortium, also explained on how the articulation process is now streamlined by high schools coming together as a group to articulate and develop courses and work in conjunction with Moorpark College, rather than faculty having to meet with individual high schools. This process improves the efforts of our faculty and the timeline of the courses articulated.
