Meeting Start Time: 1:05 p.m.

- A. Curriculum Representation
New members were introduced to the Curriculum Committee. Thanh Trinh is replacing Kathy Fink as the Mathematics rep. Nadia Monosov is sitting in with Elisa Setmire and will be replacing her as the Behavioral Sciences rep.
- B. Degree/Program Titles
There is an issue in Curricunet where the type of degree or program is listed twice in the title. Jerry Mansfield suggested that we not populate the title with the degree/program name and allow Curricunet to auto populate the title with the degree/program. The committee agreed to change the way degrees/programs are titled to provide a more clear standardized title.
- C. CTE Update Review
Jerry Mansfield advised the committee that multiple CTE programs were coming up for review. Candice Larson stated that she had gained a lot of experience in Curricunet and working on CTE Reviews from past reviews. Tim Samoff offered to help anyone with questions when reviewing CTE Programs based on his experience reviewing multiple CTE programs.
- D. Catalog Deadline Reminder
Jerry Mansfield reminded the Committee that Curriculum Submissions must go through the Committee by February 22nd to be included in the 2016-2017 Moorpark College catalog.
- E. Variable Units
Jerry Mansfield discussed an issue with variable units in Curricunet where a check box cannot be deactivated manually. Mary Rees said she is looking into this issue regarding state requirements for submission of variable unit courses.
