Curriculum Committee Minutes March 8, 2016

Minutes

Meeting start time: 1:05 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: February 25, 2016

Wade Bradford moved to approve the minutes. Mary LaBarge seconded the motion to approve the minutes. Motion passed with no abstentions.

DISCUSSION:

- A. C-ID for CTE
Jerry Mansfield informed the Committee that the Course Identification Numbering System (C-ID) is hosting two Discipline Input Group (DIG) meetings in March and April. This is a chance to discuss the potential to create model curriculum for certificates in programs. Participation is encouraged and the meetings are on a “come one, come all” basis to encourage wide participation and perspectives.
- B. ADT Revisions
Jerry Mansfield explained that CurricUNET automatically will update the number of a course but the state does not know when there are changes. Jerry Mansfield asks that the departments make a decision as to whether they want these changes handled by Letrisha Mai, our articulation officer, or have faculty initiate the changes and send the degree through the approval process. Letrisha Mai and Mary LaBarge would like to know what kind of timeline would be used to make these changes so that the Committee will know when to submit items to the state. Wade Bradford expressed optimism about the response from the Moorpark College faculty on this matter.
- C. Moorpark Curriculum Review Schedule
Jerry Mansfield presented the new Moorpark College Curriculum Review calendar to the Committee. Some in the Committee requested that it be sent out by email to the entire Committee. Members of the faculty expressed some concern that having the 2 year and 5 year are too close together causing hardship on faculty members. This will be discussed by faculty in their departments and potential changes should be referred to Curriculum Technician Michael Trainor.
- D. Substantial Change Proposal Spring 2016
This item was not discussed and will be addressed at a later date.
- E. CurricUNET Department Peer Approvals
Jerry Mansfield spoke on an issue with CurricUNET causing some confusion with department peer approvals. Jerry Mansfield stated that when a peer reviews a course it will move on through curriculum and will no longer be available to other peers. Jerry Mansfield also noted that the CurricUNET notices to faculty peers go only to faculty who have Faculty Peer status in the system.
