### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** March 8, 2016

### **DISCUSSION:**

- A. Follow-up to ADT Revisions  
Jerry Mansfield followed up from the last meeting about whether Letrisha Mai should take over the ADT revisions for faculty. The committee approved Letrisha Mai taking over the ADT revisions for faculty. For substantial changes, faculty must still send it through the curriculum process. Letrisha Mai asked for a timeline for these revisions. Letrisha Mai suggested that we put the degrees on the last meeting agenda in May. She will finish and submit them to the state inventory over the summer.
- B. Substantial Change Proposal Spring 2016  
Lori Bennett presented the Substantial Change Proposal Spring 2016 report to the Curriculum Committee. Lori Bennett told the committee that she collaborated with staff to build this report and thanked those involved for their efforts. The ACCJC reviewed this report and found it to be accurate without any needs for changes. The report noted that there are 18 new degrees and 11 new certificates since the last time this data was collected.
- C. Moorpark College in the Newspaper  
Lori Bennett presented two newspaper articles that recently featured Moorpark College. The first article spoke of the new Game program was at Moorpark College which was praised in the article for introducing a highly modernized program to the Ventura Community College District. The second article described an even at Moorpark College where the Theatre department and the Criminal Justice department collaborated to create a mock crime scene. The scene was acted out by the Theatre students while the investigation was carried out by the Criminal Justice students.
