DISCUSSION:

- A. Chancellor's Office Curriculum Inventory
Julius Sokenu informed the Committee that Moorpark College is a pilot college for the new State Chancellor's inventory system. Due to concerns of inefficiency, the State Chancellor has asked for the pilot colleges to help test the new inventory. For the new system to work properly, submissions need to be in by January 27th, 2017. At that point the old inventory will go dark and the test inventory will be available. The old submissions that are pending will be rejected and sent back similar to a revision request. Everything that is not approved will be migrated to the new system. A benefit of being part of the pilot schools is we will be able to test and help in the development of the software to better serve us. We will also have priority for our curriculum submissions with quicker rates of approval. The new system should be available by Fall of 2017.
