A. Public Comments

Mary Rees mentioned there were articles in different newspapers supporting our transfer program.

B. Current Events

Jerry Mansfield reminded everyone about our transition from CurricUNET to CourseLeaf. The first data transfer has been extracted. The second data transfer will take place sometime in the month of November. Right now, October 18th is the date we are using to move our curriculum forward and ready for the data transfer. He said that we might have to increase our Tech Review meetings to meet the demands in increasing curriculum processing. Jerry will discuss it with the Tech Review members. There was concern among the committee members regarding the October 18th date. There was discussion in possibly changing the date to ensure all curriculum is transferred to CourseLeaf. There was no change in date.

Letrisha Mai suggested we review the submission timeline to remind the committee members of the curriculum approval process. Jerry and Letrisha reviewed the Curriculum Submission Timeline with the committee. They reminded everyone there are several factors that may cause a delay, after curriculum has been reviewed and approved by our Curriculum Committee. These delays may be outside of our control. Jerry reminded all that supporting documentation, such as narrative, LMI, advisory minutes, etc., are important and required for submission to the state for approval. These documents must be in CurricUNET and ready for submission by Tech Review. If these documents are required and not ready by Tech Review, the course or program will not move forward. Ruth Bennington asked if there was any particular order or a priority list for items going through Tech Review. Jerry said there is no particular order and it is first come, first serve. Mary LaBarge suggested reviewing the COR carefully before submitting it for Tech Review. Errors in grammar, spelling, book sources, and the overall items required in a COR are the things that delay the Tech Review process.

Mary Rees said CTE will take certificates to the region for approval. Nenagh Brown asked if October 18, is still the date we should use as our goal to have curriculum in on time. Jerry responded and said it is possible the date may change.

Letrisha Mai asked about the GE Workgroup. The following members confirmed they will be in the GE Workgroup: Letrisha Mai, Hugo Hernandez, Mary LaBarge, Scarlet Relle, and Svetlana Kasalovic. Svetlana said that Candice Larson will also be part of the GE Workgroup.
