

## FIRST LEVEL TRANSFER MATH PLACEMENT FOR HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS

Students may now enroll directly into any one of the first-level transferable classes in Math.  
The following guidelines will help you determine the Mathematics course in which you are most prepared:

Math M05 (College Algebra)  
Math M06 (Trigonometry)  
Math M07 (Pre-Calculus)

Math M10 (Mathematics for Elementary Teachers)  
Math M15 (Introduction to Statistics)

*If you have successfully completed High School Algebra II,  
you may freely enroll in any of our first level transferable courses*

*If you have not successfully completed High School Algebra II, please consider below the courses you are  
**recommended** to enroll in, based on your previous high school experience:*

**If your goal is to complete Math M05, Math M06 or Math M07:**

- 1) Your High School GPA is at least 2.8: You are recommended to enroll in **Math M03**
- 2) Your High School GPA is below 2.8: You are recommended to enroll in **Math M01**
- 3) If you still wish to enroll in one of these three courses, regardless of the above recommendations, you to enroll in **Math M05 + Math M905-S** (College Algebra with Support)

**If your goal is to complete Math M10:** You may directly enroll.

**If your goal is to complete Math M15:**

- 1) You have successfully completed High School Algebra I AND your High School GPA is at least 3.0:  
  
You are recommended to enroll directly into **Math M15**
- 2) You have not successfully completed High School Algebra I OR your High School GPA is below 3.0:  
  
You are recommended to enroll in **Math M08** (Pathway to Statistics)  
OR  
Either **Math M03** (if your GPA is at least 2.8) or **Math M01** (if your GPA was below 2.8).
