Frequently Asked Questions about PALS

What is PALS?

PALS stands for Peer Assisted Learning Sessions.

A trained student math tutor leads pre- arranged small group study sessions for a specific math section/class at the direction or request of the instructor. A minimum of 4 students are needed for these group sessions.

What if I want a weekly PAL session?

The programwill start with booking PAL sessions one by one. After a successful session, the students in the group may book another session for the following week.

What happens if only a couple of students show up for PALS?

Students will always be accommodated in the Tutoring Center, on a first-come, first-served basis, but they may not have as much time to work with the tutor as they would have in the group and may have to wait for a tutor to become available.

How can I cancel a session?
