#### I. Public Comments

 Moorpark faculty, Linda Loiselle and Robert Gregg, expressed concern about reports they had heard that ASC was rerunning the election for Vice President. It was noted that this was on the agenda for this meeting.

## IV. Committee Reports

- Curriculum Committee(M Tennant) The Curriculum Committee discussed the need for ASC to develop a procedure for nominating candidates for the position of Curriculum CoChair.
- Facilities CAP (P Abramoff)

Academic Center is still on schedule for completion in 2010. Equipment and furnishings for 33 classrooms will need to be decided. Dean's Council and EVP will decide which departments will populate the Center. ASC may want to give some input on this.

Health Center will need to be equipped and furnished, with some funding by Measure S. EATM in second phase, bids are about to go out.

Projects to be prioritized include plans for ACCESS, plans for area that will be vacated by HS trailers when Health Science Building is completed.

Copy Center plans: District wide vendor that will provide staffed service is proposed.

Colleges are reviewing: walk-in or self-service should be avoided, electronic submission might be possible. ASC should be involved in the decision process.

- Faculty Development (N Brown) Two proposals were approved to receive funding from mini grant funds: service learning and learning communities proposals.
- District (M Tennant)

DCHR –Draft of Admin Policies AP 7120-B Recruitment and Hiring faculty was distributed to the committee for review and comments at the March 17 meeting.

The Board of Trustees will hear recommendations for uniform professional titles for instructors at VCCCD colleges. ASC approved professional titles for Moorpark College faculty in 2007.

#### V. Unfinished Business

• Recommendations of ad hoc committee on ASC officer election concerns – 2<sup>nd</sup> reading
The ad hoc committee report was read to the ASC by the ad hoc committee chair: the committee
examined voting records, ballots, and campaign literature that was distributed to adjunct faculty, and
concluded that the campaign literature contained misleading information about the powers of
ASC Vice President that might have influenced the outcome of the election. They recommended that
another election be held for the office of ASC Vice President.

Motion was made to adopt the ad hoc committee's recommendation to rerun the election for ASC Vice President, motion was seconded, and a standing vote was held. The results of the vote were 7 For, 10 Opposed, and 4 Abstained. The recommendation to rerun the election was rejected.

Discussion: The Academic Senate Constitution and Bylaws do not address specific guidelines for elections. At the February 3 ASC meeting, ASC President, Margaret Tennant, convened an ad hoc committee to develop guidelines on election procedures to add to the Senate Bylaws. Volunteers for the committee were Rolland Petrello, Nenagh Brown, Melanie Masters, Kristi Almeida-Bowin, and Clint Harper.

# • Administrative Policy AP 4025 - third reading

AP 4025 Philosophy and criteria for Associate Degree and General Education – The policy was reviewed by Chuck Brinkman, counseling faculty, who proposed it be approved with no revisions. It was moved, seconded, and the vote was unanimous to approve as written.
