

Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC)

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT IGETC

The Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) is a general education program which California Community College transfer students may use to fulfill lower-division general education requirements in either the UC or CSU system without the need, after transfer, to take additional lower-division general education courses. The IGETC is most useful for students who want to keep their options open before making a final decision about transferring to a particular UC or CSU campus. *Completion of IGETC does not guarantee admission, nor is it required for admission.*

Some students may be better served by taking courses which fulfill the CSU General Education-Breadth requirements or those of the UC campus or college to which they plan to transfer. STUDENTS PURSUING MAJORS THAT REQUIRE EXTENSIVE LOWER-DIVISION MAJOR PREPARATION MAY NOT FIND THE IGETC OPTION TO BE ADVANTAGEOUS. Engineering, Architecture and Liberal Studies are examples of those majors. *Roosevelt and Revelle Colleges at UC San Diego, the School of Business at Berkeley and the College of Environmental Design (Architecture and Landscape Architecture majors) at Berkeley will not accept the IGETC.* SCHOOLS OF ENGINEERING DO NOT GENERALLY RECOMMEND THE IGETC - see a counselor for assistance in planning your program.

All courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. *Foreign work may not be used.* Course credit earned on the basis of acceptable scores on Advanced Placement exams which are recognized by faculty as equivalent to approved IGETC courses can be applied toward IGETC certification. *Courses completed at a California Community College will be applied to the subject area in which they were listed by the institution where the work was completed.* Course work from other regionally accredited institutions will be placed in the same subject area as the equivalent MOORPARK COLLEGE course. Only courses deemed equivalent to those on the MOORPARK COLLEGE approved IGETC course list will be certified.

CERTIFICATION: *"Certification" means that the last community college attended prior to transfer to the UC or CSU will verify that the student has completed the IGETC. It is the student's responsibility to request "certification" during the last semester of attendance at MOORPARK COLLEGE prior to transfer.*

Certification is done by the last Community College of attendance. It is strongly recommended that, before petitioning the IGETC certification, students consult their MOORPARK COLLEGE counselor regarding fulfillment of IGETC requirements.

PARTIAL IGETC CERTIFICATION:

If you are approaching readiness for transfer and, for good cause, are unable to complete one or two IGETC courses, please see your counselor.

MINIMUM UC TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSIONS EFFECTIVE FALL 1998 —

- Complete 60 units
- Earn at least a 2.4 GPA (Please note: a 2.4 GPA is the minimum GPA for UC eligibility. However, many UC campuses require a higher GPA to be competitive. Consult your MOORPARK COLLEGE counselor for specific information)
- Complete a specific pattern of courses: two transferable English courses, one transferable math course, four transferable courses chosen from at least two of the following areas:
 - Art and Humanities
 - Social and Behavioral Sciences
 - Physical and Biological Sciences

(COMPLETION OF IGETC WILL AUTOMATICALLY FULFILL THESE REQUIREMENTS.)

MEETING FOREIGN LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT (UC only)

The Foreign Language requirement for IGETC may be met in one of the following ways:

1. Satisfactory completion of any MC foreign language course level I or higher.
2. Completion of two years of the same foreign language in high school with grade of "C" or better in the last semester of the 2nd year.
3. Satisfactory completion of 2 or more years of formal schooling at the 6th grade level or higher in an institution where the language of instruction is not English.
4. Completion of a course at a college or university with a grade of "C" or better (any course, excluding conversation courses) to be equivalent to 2 years of high school language may be used.
5. Equivalent proficiency demonstrated by a minimum score of 3 on an AP exam in languages other than English.
6. A score of 5 or higher on the International Baccalaureate Higher Level Exam in languages other than English.
7. Satisfactory score on the SAT II: Subject Test in languages other than English.

Before May 1995 use 1st score; If taken after May 1995 use 2nd score.

IGETC CHECKLIST

- The institution is accredited by the Western Association of Schools & Colleges, or an equivalent accrediting body.
- The course is lower division.
- A course taken at a California Community College is applied to the subject area in which it is listed by the institution where the work was completed (check: www.assist.org for College's IGETC list).
- Coursework taken at an institution other than a California Community College is used on IGETC only if MC offers an equivalent course and that course appears on MC's IGETC pattern.
- Grade received in course is "C" or better. "C-" is not acceptable.
- Course work is not from a foreign university.
- Each course is a minimum of 3 semester or 4 quarter units.
- Course must be a minimum of 4 semester or 5 quarter units to fulfill the IGETC lab requirement.
- All courses on IGETC are completed by the end of the semester you are petitioning for certification.
