# B. C-ID Conditional Approvals

• The College is doing a great job of developing TMC for the AA or AS degree. We are moving toward having a TMC for every AA/AS degree. The State now requires that courses on a TMC meet the C-ID if one is available. Even if a course has been through the Curriculum process recently and there are new changes to the C-ID, they must go through again. Courses with C-ID must now match 100%.

#### C. District GE

The Districts BP and AP 4100 regarding District GE were reviewed. The modifications will be voted upon at the next Curriculum meeting. If approved the revisions will be sent to Academic Senate.

#### D. Repeatability

To meet Title 5 changes, all courses that are no longer repeatable have now been changed in CurricUNET.
Modification were also sent to the State to show course can only be taken once. This was approved by the committee.

#### E. Stand-alone

 During the process of improving the state CurricUNET site it was noted that some courses were marked as standalone incorrectly. Attached is the list is all the courses that were marked at the State as stand-alone incorrectly. They will now be changed to match current COR. This was approved by the committee.
