## **MINUTES**

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: April 2, 2013 & April 9, 2013 - approved

#### **DISCUSSION:**

#### A. Summary & Goals

Courses and programs were reviewed as part of their five-year cycle. Repeatability was removed from required CORs as per new changes to Title 5. Families were developed to provide additional skills development as required for transfer institutions. Documentation is being kept to verify the CORs which are still repeatable. These would be CORs for courses that require repeats at four-year institutions. A new AP has been written by a District GE committee and approved by Curriculum and the Academic Senate. The new AP is going to the BOT for approval. This new AP establishes criteria for determining if a course meets local GE. It also requires that GEOs be determined and evaluated. The District GE Committee, with the support of local GE Committees and Curriculum Committees at all three colleges, also evaluated courses that were approved for local GE. Similar courses that had discrepant GE were evaluated in an effort to provide consistency regarding GE for the students of the district. Major strides were made on developing additional 1440 degrees. The SLO portion of the CORs are being updated as the CORs come through the curricular review process. A new AP was developed and approved by Curriculum and Academic Senate and submitted to the Board which would allow for content review in the establishment of prerequisites. Approved updates to CORs to meet state-approved C-IDs to meet the June timeline.

## Possible Goals for 2013-2014:

- Continue implementation of COR/program cycle of review.
- Work towards compliance on degrees, TOP codes, and other measures utilized in the state Curriculum Inventory.
- Work on development for additional 1440 degrees.
- Establish processes and training for the use of content review for the establishment of prerequisites.
- Continue review of CORs that were self-certified as equivalent to state C-IDs.
- Establish models for DE addendum on CORs to facilitate pedagogy and documentation of student contact.
- Establish credit-by-exam exceptions.
- Work with the CTE programs to define and provide information on market needs for new and revised CTE programs.
