C. M22A/B & M80 Courses

A uniform template for all M80s and M22A/B was previously approved but there has been uneven application of
these templates. All M22A/B were to be renumbered as M122. Following discussion it was determined that the
change in numbering will be done for the Faculty. But the Departments will update courses using the template
according to their 5-year review.

D. Fall Fling

The Institutional Outcomes which will be discussed at Fall Fling were reviewed.

E. 5-Year SLO Plan Link with Curriculum

• There was discussion of the Academic Senate proposal to link up the 5-year SLO review with the 5-year Curriculum review cycle. A Department will complete its review of SLOs the year before its curricular review. This would allow a Department to modify their CORs if deemed necessary.
