- A. DCAA
  - Reviewed process for substantial changes: DCAA is a new committee for reviewing courses and programs going to the BOT. First step in process, after CC, is DTRW-I which checks for legal and technical concerns. All curricular changes will go to DCAA and then on to the BOT. After approval has been met by the BOT, it goes on to the State for approval.
- B. GE Area F
  - Propose re-defining title as Ethnic/Gender Studies rather than the current Ethnic/Women Studies.
  - Discussion on definition of gender. The committee supports the change.
- C. TMC/C-ID
  - State is requesting TMC information from Community Colleges. Moorpark is on track to implement transfer degrees within most of the areas. C-ID may question methods of evaluation section of course objectives. More specific information may be requested from the C-ID reviewer.

  - Recently approved program and course discontinuance from President. Question was posed if Mary should go ahead and start the process or have the individual faculty initiate it. Check with faculty first and then start process through CurricUNET.
