FY 13-14 Work Plan for Workgroup on GEOs:

Fall 2013: Analytical Thinking

Convene a work group that constitutes the analytical thinking Disciplines; 6 disciplines (COM, CS, ENGL, PHIL, MATH and JOUR ) examine the 3 GEOs and formulate rubrics for assessing the GEOs. Invite Julie Campbell to participate in workgroup. The Work group reports back to GE Subcommittee, which then reports to Curriculum.
