ONE: The name of this Corporation is THE MOORPARK COLLEGE FOUNDATION.

TWO: This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for public and charitable purposes. The public purposes for which this corporation is organized include the promotion of the general welfare of Moorpark College by assisting and supporting the attainment of educational, scientific and cultural goals, by assisting it in fulfilling its role of service to its community, by soliciting and distributing money for its facilities, equipment, beautification and any other educational outlay needed for scholarships, loans and grants to students.

THREE: The name and address in this state of the corporation's initial agent for service of process is W. Ray Hearon, Moorpark College, 7075 Campus Road, Moorpark, California 93021.

FOUR: (a) The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes, and no part of the net income or assets of this organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member of this corporation, or to the benefit of any private individual.

(b) Upon the dissolution and winding up of this corporation, and after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation that is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and that has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

FIVE: (a) This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (i) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (ii) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States

(b) No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propoganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, nor shall this corporation participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for political office.

This is in response to your request of August 17, 2004, regarding your organization's tax-exempt status.


