- NOTES 2. Full IGETC certification requires the completion of ALL Areas (including Area 6 LOTE). Partial certification allows for missing a maximum of two courses. Partial certification that does not include completion of Areas 1 and/or 2 may make a student ineligible for meeting the minimum admission transfer requirements for CSU and/or UC.
 - 3. A course must have a minimum unit value of 3 semester or 4 quarter units and must be completed with a "C" or better, or Pass/Credit. A grade of "C-" is not acceptable. The UC system allows a maximum of 14 semester units graded "Pass/No-Pass".
