1. IGETC may be used to meet the lower division general education for the CSU and/or UC. IGETC is not recommended for all majors and may not be appropriate for majors in Science, Technology, Engineering, Math (STEM) area. IGETC for STEM is only available for ADTs in Biology, Chemistry and Env Science, consult with a counselor.

NOTES

2. Full IGETC certification requires the completion of ALL Areas (including Area 6 LOTE). Partial certification allows for missing a maximum of two courses. Partial certification that does not include completion of Areas 1 and/or 2 may make a student ineligible for meeting the minimum admission transfer requirements for CSU and/or UC.
3. A course must have a minimum unit value of 3 semester or 4 quarter units and must be completed with a "C" or better, or Pass/Credit. A grade of "C-" is not acceptable. The UC system allows a maximum of 14 semester units graded "Pass/No-Pass".
