## **ART HISTORY (AA-T)**

Program Requirements: Includes course requirements and sequencing that reflect program goals.

To earn an AA-T in Art History, students must complete the following:

- 1. 60 semester units or 90 quarter CSU transferable units.
- 2. Minimum grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.0 in all
- 3. CSU transferable coursework. While a minimum of 2.0 is required for admission, some majors may require a higher GPA.
- 4. A minimum of 18-20 specified major units. All courses in the major must be completed with a grade of C or better (Title 5 §55063).
- 5. Certified completion of the California State University General Education-Breadth pattern or the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC for CSU) pattern.
